

LOOK & CURATE PROGRAM FREE EXCURSION FOR VISUAL ART STUDENTS

Look & Curate is an Education Program which offers Visual Art classes a free excursion to Wollongong Art Gallery. This two-hour excursion begins with a guided tour of WAG's current exhibitions followed by an activity where students curate their own exhibition using the Gallery's Collection as their inspiration. Teachers can book their groups on a day and time that suits their school timetable.

Students will learn about the role of the curator and what a curator does within a Gallery context. The Conceptual Framework will be the study focus. This excursion is best suited for years 10 – 12 students.
